

# Future Corps

*A partnership of Neutral Zone and City of Ann Arbor*

**Participants:** Youth aged 18-22

**Goal:** To assist youth in navigating a successful transition into adulthood through mentorship, academic certification, and employment in order to ensure future stability and growth

**Post-Phase Outcomes:**

- Youth will have completed an academic/technical Associate’s degree or Certification program.
- Youth will have gained at least 1 year of work experience with the City, making them a viable candidate for future employment opportunities.
- Youth will develop lasting relationships with community members who will continue to provide a circle of support and resources.
