On April 15, 2026, the City of Ann Arbor sustained widespread and severe damage caused by a tornado. As a result of this situation, the following conditions exist: The City's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) is activated and has been coordinating the response to over 100 downed lines and trees requiring a substantial road clearing response, a wall collapse at Veteran's Memorial Park, damage to city property, several structures with roof damage, widespread power outages, debris management, with overtime hours incurred.

Therefore, as Mayor of the City of Ann Arbor in accordance with Section 10 of 1976 Public Act 390, as amended, I hereby declare that a "state of emergency" exists within our jurisdiction as of April 15, 2026, and that local resources are being utilized to the fullest possible extent. The response and recovery elements of our emergency operations plan have been activated.
