Chapter 59: Off-Street Parking Ordinance

Applicability

Bicycle parking must be provided ...

- When a site plan is required
 - *New buildings or additions to existing buildings*
 - *Expansions to existing parking lots*
 - *Changes to required site elements*

Class A: Enclosed Bicycle Storage

- Overnight
- Long term storage
- Secure bicycle and accessories



Class B: Covered Bicycle Racks

- Daily
- Dry, shaded
- Secure bicycle



Class C: Fixed Bicycle Racks

- Short term, hourly
- Convenient
- Secure bicycle



Three Components to Bicycle Parking

- Number of Spaces
- Class Distribution
- Design Criteria
