I live at 1835 Cambridge Road, directly behind 805 Oxford Road.

I read with interest your report on the drainage at the latter, where there is proposed reconstruction, and I want to share my worries with you since my property is directly downhill from the subject property, and could get more stormwater runoff after reconstruction than I already do.

Specifically, the topographical water-flow diagrams suggest that they will have water from the large parking lot (and possibly some of the roof discharge) flow SouthEast along the parking lot and then flow South West along the SouthEastern boundary. I could not figure out where they would place stormwater drain(s) to carry water to Mallett's Creek. I am hoping you can reassure me that you are satisfied that their stormwater drain placement is such that water from the large parking area (or the roof) will not come towards my house. If that is not the case, could you please require that they place such drain(s)?
