Hello,

I am writing about the rezoning of 2525 Ann Arbor Saline Road, Project Number RES-PROJ24-0004. The plan is to rezone the parcel from O (office) to R4E (residential). When I bought my home on Northbrook, this area was not, still is not, zoned for the proposed five story building. In the April 4<sup>th</sup> meeting, the developer admitted under the current zoning, he would be allowed to build a 1-2 story apartment building. I would be happy with this shorter proposal. However, I have two large issues with this proposal.

- 1. It dramatically changes the skyline of the area.
  - a. I will be looking at this large building out of my front yard. If I wanted this, I would have bought a property downtown.
  - b. The building will sit on a hill and stand out for miles. The developers are intentionally only including areal pictures. I have added some drawings of how it will be seen from Northbrook, Landsdown, and Lawton homes. Please see attached.
- 2. The building will not have enough parking.
  - a. In the April 4<sup>th</sup> meeting, the developer admitted the residents would need many additional parking spaces that the property would not accommodate. He said he is planning on using neighboring parking areas for the parking needs of their residents.

Ann Arbor needs more homeowners and less out of state developers. Please do not support this rezoning proposal.


# Stop the 2525 Ann Arbor Saline Rd Rezoning




