**V OLD BUSINESS**

A. Meter Replacement Project Update

- *Over 95% complete; remaining meters are being replaced by public works technicians.*
- *Currently focusing on the large meter replacements and U of M. Remaining small meter replacements are on hold, staff is accommodating replacements based on request.*
- *There are 150 property owners that are currently paying a \$50.00 surcharge per billing cycle since they have been non-responsive to requests to replace their water meter. Next steps include water shut-off notices for approved locations.*

B. Service Line Inventory & Replacement Update

- *Complete Distribution Systems Material Inventory (CDSMI) is due to EGLE on October 16, 2024.*

- *Noted to included these results in the water newsletter.*
- *163 locations need to have the materials verified from the curb box to the home.*
- *There is some overlap on these locations and the meter replacement locations. Targeted time frame for additional outreach would be late Summer/Fall 2024.*
- *New contractor started this spring. Each replacement is about \$10,000.*
- *Currently on track to have all replacements completed by 2030. In all there have been 425 replacements since the program began.*

C. Updates on Federal Guidelines (EPA)

- *EPA anticipates finalizing the proposed LCRI items outlined in the November 30, 2023, EPA announcement prior to October 16, 2024.*
- *EPA is also working on issues around PFAs and micro-plastics in the water supply, though these topics are not part of the council's mandates.*

- *Points to highlight include educational materials can be found at Michigan.gov/KnowYourWater*
- *A2 has utilized parts of the toolkit for LCR webpage and plans on using relevant collateral for upcoming communications/newsletter.*
- *Paul Matthews, the city's Public Works Manager, will be presenting to SDWAC on A2's materials inventory & replacement program at their next meeting on June 12, 2024.*
