Dear Ann Arbor City Council,

I am writing to protect the proposed Ordinance No. ORD-16-20-Weber Zoning. I understand that the Ann Arbor City Council will conduct a public hearing regarding this proposal on November 21 at 7:00 p.m.

The proposal to build 56 homes on this property will overwhelm our already fragile infrastructure in the neighborhood. Please consider the following:

- The property is a haven for many animals, especially deer, which wander through our yards.
- Utilities in the area are taxed. My neighbors and I have reported electrical outages and sewer backups are an issue in this area.
- The already congested Packard Road is not equipped to handle more traffic.
- Many mature trees are on the property.
- Fifty-six homes on the property is extremely dense and crowded for the site.

Please reconsider the rezoning of this property and vote "no" on the proposal to rezone 2857 Packard Road, Ordinance No. ORD-16-20-Weber Zoning.
