Background & Overview: Restoration or Rehabilitation Core Elements

- Repair existing pavement surface
- Some curb replacement (as needed)
- Work contained within the existing road footprint
- Data collection – minimal
- Detailed design – minimal



2026 Season: Annual Street Resurfacing Program

- Fourth Ave (Liberty to William) - DDA




2026 Season: Nixon Road (Phase 2)
