(f) (6) As used in this section subsection (b) failure to pay fine and costs, "person" means not only an individual, partnership, corporation, limited liability company, association, or other legal entity, but also includes the partners, or members, and managers of a firm, a partnership, or an association, and the officers of a corporation, property manager(s), and agents of any of the foregoing.

- (g) (e) Defenses. It is an affirmative defense to this section that a court of competent jurisdiction stayed the order issued by the administrative hearing officer before the effective date of the order and that the order is currently stayed.
- (h) (d) Prohibited defenses. It is not a defense to this section that a person:
 - (1) Came into compliance or attempted to come into compliance with the order after the date the order by its terms required compliance; or
 - (2) Sought judicial review of the order, but failed to obtain a stay of the order before the date the order by its terms required compliance.
- (i) (e) Venue. The City Attorney must institute actions under this section in a court of competent jurisdiction.
- Severability. If any clause, sentence, section, paragraph, or part of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person, firm, corporation, legal entity, or circumstances, shall be for any reason adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not effect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance and the application of such provision to other persons, firms, corporations, legal entities, or circumstances by such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, section, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance thereof directly involved in the case or controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered and to the person, firm, corporation, legal entity, or circumstances then and there involved. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent of this body that the Ordinance would have been adopted had such invalid or unconstitutional provisions not been included in this Ordinance.
- Repeal. All other Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistencies, hereby repealed.
- Savings Clause. The balance of the Code of Ordinances, City of Ypsilanti, Michigan, except as herein or previously amended, shall remain in full force and effect. The repeal provided herein shall not abrogate or affect any offense or act committed or done, or any penalty or forfeiture incurred, or any pending fee, assessments, litigation, or prosecution of any right established, occurring prior to the effective date hereof.
