

Micro-Mobility Subcommittee Meeting Notes January 7, 2019

In Attendance: Scott Trudeau, Lisa Solomon, Eli Cooper, Raymond Hess, John Fournier, Kayla Coleman

Member of the Public: Jesse Halfon

1. We reviewed the latest staff comments on the Statement of Values document and incorporated changes from the recent Transportation Commission meeting. An updated draft is forthcoming from Scott Trudeau.
2. We discussed the need previously identified for updates to our ordinances to clarify where and how new vehicle types including e-scooters may be permissibly operated and to ensure our local ordinance is consistent with recent changes to State law and the City's goals. Staff indicated that work on a draft ordinance is already underway and committed to providing a draft for subcommittee review by our February 4th meeting. The draft will incorporate values from the Statement of Values and consider feedback already received from the Subcommittee and Commission.
3. A member of the public, Jesse Halfon, spoke and addressed the meeting about an upcoming micro-mobility conference and issues of micro-mobility broadly. He also provided additional materials (see attached).
4. Near the end of the meeting staff noted that Bird had removed all of their scooters 4 days prior and had yet to share any data or remit any payments under the terms of the very recently signed initial contract.
