I have been studying the Comprehensive Plan for almost a year now. I want to make sure that everyone reads the Plan carefully before discussing it at your meeting.

Nowhere does it require developers to build anything affordable, ever. It does mention "naturally occurring affordable housing" but gives no means to protect what is already there. It does not mention the Renters Commission, or that Ann Arbor even has one.

The Renters Commission should demand that their concerns be directly addressed in the Comp Plan with action plans. It should demand that the draft be sent back and rewritten to include real, achievable solutions for renters in Ann Arbor.
