Moved by Kathy Fortener, Seconded by Bob White, that the Commission issue a certificate of appropriateness for the application at 511 East Ann Street, a contributing property in the Old Fourth Ward Historic District, to do the following work: Construct a two-story rear addition; Replace a portion of the foundation; Install a timber egress well and new egress window on the rear wing; Replace the asphalt shingle roof and the metal front porch roof with matching materials; Remove a chimney from the rear wing; Demolish a non-contributing rear porch; Install new wood shutters on the front elevation: Install aluminum storm windows: Fill in a window well on the east elevation; Remove and replace portions of the non-historic fencing; Install three new gravel parking spaces in the northeast corner of the rear yard; Install a new walkway to the rear door; And add two air conditioning condensers behind the main house block, as proposed. This work is compatible in exterior design, arrangement, texture, material and relationship to the rest of the building and the surrounding area and meets The Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation and Guidelines for Rehabilitating Historic Buildings, in particular standards 1, 2, 5, 6, 9, and 10 and the guidelines for additions and building site, as well as the Ann Arbor Historic District Design Guideline for all additions.
