getDowntown Program

- Provides commuting programs and services to employees and employers
- Founded in 1999
- Ongoing partnership between the TheRide, Ann Arbor DDA, and the City of Ann Arbor
- Maintains office hours at Blake Transit Center











Benefits for Employers and Commuters



- Free services
 - Commute consulting & resources
 - Challenge participation
- Benefits linked to go!pass
 - Unlimited ride pass on TheRide and FlexRide
 - Discount on Holiday and Late Night Service
 - Emergency Ride Home reimbursement
 - Discounts at local businesses
 - Workplace must be within DDA boundary to be eligible



Program Activities





Spring 2023 through Spring 2024 Activities

- Surveyed downtown commuters and employers to learn how services can better suit their needs
- Ran three challenges to encourage, amplify and reward alternative commuting
- Supplied 237 employers (and counting) with go!passes valid until October
- Increased frequency of e-newsletter





Remaining Activities for FY24

- Continue go!pass outreach
- Promote Commuter Challenge, Bike to Wherever Day, and Bike-a-Palooza
- Share information regarding expanded service offerings from TheRide and Ann Arbor planning initiatives

Expanded Services and Opportunities for Improved Partnership


Expanded Services on TheRide begins in 2024 Spring

- Limited-stop express route between Ann Arbor-Ypsilanti
 Late Summer
- Longer hours of service on weekdays and weekend evenings
- Increased frequency of service on the weekends
- Expanded and improved overnight service

go!pass Use on TheRide is Still Increasing




Q3 note: go!passes expire October 31st of each year and employees rely on their employer to provide new passes to ride in November.






The percentage increase in ridership can be unpredictable year to year.

getDowntown Funding Request for DDA FY25

Program or Service	FY24	FY25	Purpose
Promotion and Marketing	Not to exceed \$75,000	Not to exceed \$105,000	Increase due to outreach for service improvements, 25 years of the go!pass, anticipated investment in challenge platform, increasing visibility of employer exemplars.
Fixed-Route Fares (go!pass)	Not to exceed \$498,914	<i>Not to exceed</i> \$468,914	Transit incentive for employees that increases bus use and frees up parking spaces for other users.
Non-fixed Route Discounts	Not to exceed \$32,000	Not to exceed \$32,000	Expanded service area and improvements to shuttle deployment could increase utilization. Includes discounts for NightRide, HolidayRide and FlexRide East and West.
Total:	\$605,914	\$605,914	No change.



Impact of DDA getDowntown grants

- Estimated \$1.48 million in annual savings for downtown employees
- 53,560 gallons of fuel saved compared to taking conventional vehicle
- 503 tons of GHG saved by bus trips compared to midsized vehicle
