Dear Mr. Dohoney Jr.:

Washtenaw County wishes to amend the contract with your agency. Per the current contract, the parties may agree to written amendments signed by the parties. If this amendment is agreeable to you, please sign and return all copies of this letter. You will receive an executed copy of this letter upon completion.

Accordingly, I hereby amend the original Service Contract between Washtenaw County and City of Ann Arbor dated March 1, 2012, the Renewal Agreement dated July 27, 2017, Amendment dated January 13, 2022, Amendment dated April 28, 2022, Amendment dated February 1, 2023, and Amendment dated January 31, 2024, as follows:

Amend ARTICLE III – CHARGES FOR SERVICE to extend the contract as follows:

Beginning July 1, 2025, upon the above services and submission of invoices, the City of Ann Arbor will pay the County an amount not to exceed one million, one hundred and three thousand, six hundred sixty-two dollars (\$1,103,662.00) per year. Price will be set until June 30, 2026.

Amend ARTICLE IV – TERM to extend the contract as follows:

“This contract shall be in full force and effect from the most recent amendment date of March 24, 2025, until June 30, 2026”

All other terms and conditions remain the same as in the original contract, subsequent amendments and any applicable RFP/RFQ.
