Please pass the Resolution Recommending Inclusion of Natural Features Sustainability in Ann Arbor City Planning and Development. Also, please forward passage of this resolution to the City Council. Thank you!

We need to:

- Incorporate the existing Natural Features Master Plan (NFMP) into the Comprehensive Plan,
- Improve the NFMP so that it is applied for all types of future land use, not just for developments that require site plans,
- Modify the A2Zero Carbon Neutrality Plan to include actions that address Natural Features and biodiversity, for greater sustainability, and
- Retain and enforce existing regulations that protect trees, shrubs and other vegetation in Historic Districts.
