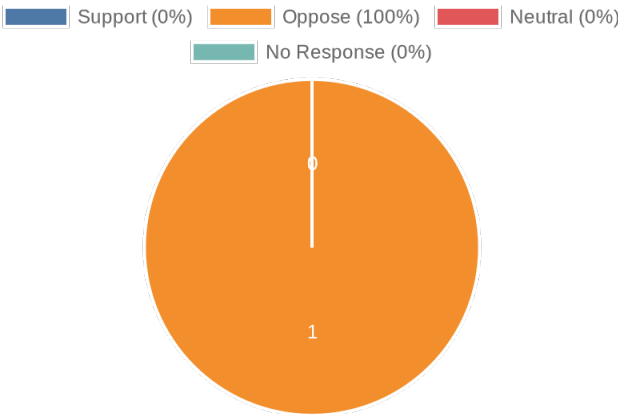

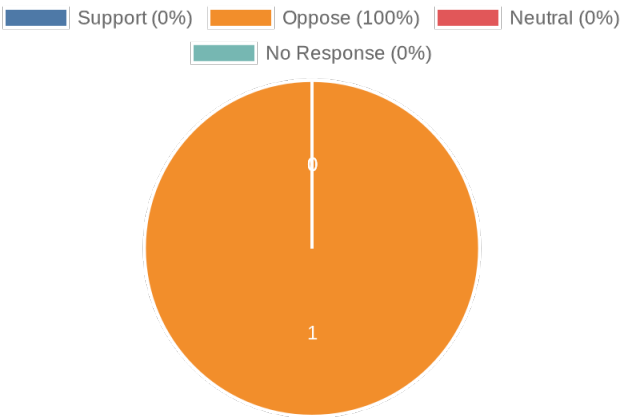

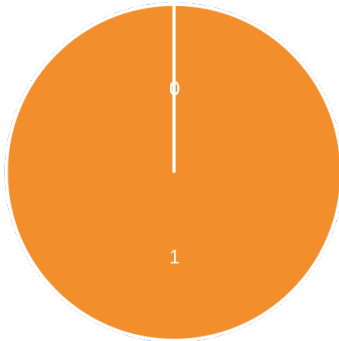
Overall Sentiment
