2018-3	5.24.18	Gender Identity	7.30.18	Employment: Transgender woman's allegations include that she was restricted by employer from using public women's restroom after customer complained.	Closed case after complainant did not respond to repeated phone calls and email messages from the HRC.
2018-4	7.14.18	None	7.26.18	Police conduct: Allegations of repeated instances of harassment in retaliation for filing a complaint to the police about an AAPD officer.	With complainant's permission, case was referred to City Attorney.
2018-5	7.24.18	Domestic Violence Victim, Gender, Disability	11.1.18	Police conduct: Allegations concern a variety of interactions with officers from the AAPD and Washtenaw County Sheriff's Office. Contacted Fair Housing Center that agreed to consider sending testers. After they were unable to do so and final conversation with complainant, case was closed.
2018-8	9.4.18	Color, Height, National Origin, Race, Sex	11.7.18	Employment: Alleges did not receive same salary, raises as other employees who had been there the same (or less) amount of time.	Investigation revealed insufficient evidence of discrimination.
2018-9	10.11.18	None	10.18.18	In County Jail awaiting hearings, seeking new attorney	Provided complainant with alternative resources.
2018-10	11.2.18	Source of Income	1.31.19	Housing: Apartment complex notified residents that it would no longer accept housing vouchers or consider them as income for the purpose of determining eligibility to rent.	Repeated conversations with parties resulted in respondent agreeing to reverse its decision and continue to accept housing vouchers.
