
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## Safe Streets for All (SS4A)



#### **Overview:**

- Funding \$3.8 federal,
   950,000 local funds
- Elements Quick Build,
   Speed Management, and
   Near Miss Analytics
- Timeframe 4 years

# RFP Details

- RFP due January7, 2025
- Council action March/April 2025

#### **Scope of Work**

- Collect "near miss" and actual crashes at existing intersections with Gridsmart Cameras across the city
- Use data to evaluate potential safety improvements and identify patterns at intersections
- Collect data for 2 years
- No data will be stored on city servers
