F REGULAR BUSINESS**F-1****DR21-002; 330 Detroit St** *(Currently 303 N Fifth St, 312 Detroit St, & 314 Detroit St)*

The petitioner proposes to construct a 5 story, 14 unit, multiple-family building (33,613 sq. ft. in total) with ground floor retail where Detroit Street bisects N. Fifth Avenue in the Farmers Market Area. The project meets LEED Gold standards and proposes an overall density of 340% (350% allowed with LEED Gold). Twenty-three parking spaces are proposed. The site is zoned D2 -Downtown Interface and is in the Kerrytown Character District.

SUBJECT: *330 Detroit Street S (DR21-002)*

Please consider the following comments and recommendations of the Design Review Board when preparing a site plan application:

1. *Comments on overall design*

- *Support more vertical elements instead of horizontal bands.*
- *Blank walls on N. Fifth Avenue need something like art or landscaping.*
- *Some of the surfaces are flat next to each other (brick should be clearly delineated from white surface instead of being flush).*
- *Canopy on Detroit Street looks like scaffolding.*
- *White material is very contrasting. Consider other colors such as charcoal or grey-green.*
- *The prow of the building feels “very Miami” and could be better integrated into the rest of the building.*
- *Light color (white) siding is “jarring”. Consider other colors. Colors on rest of building are fine.*
- *The building feels very strong until the flatiron side when it “melts” into a number of balconies.*
- *Need more relief between the brick and white surfaces.*
- *Consider wrapping the balcony around building.*
- *Other than some suggestions, love the building.*
- *Staff identified a code issue with that street-wall requirement.*

These comments and recommendations were approved by the Design Review Board at the November 10, 2021 Design Review Board meeting.
