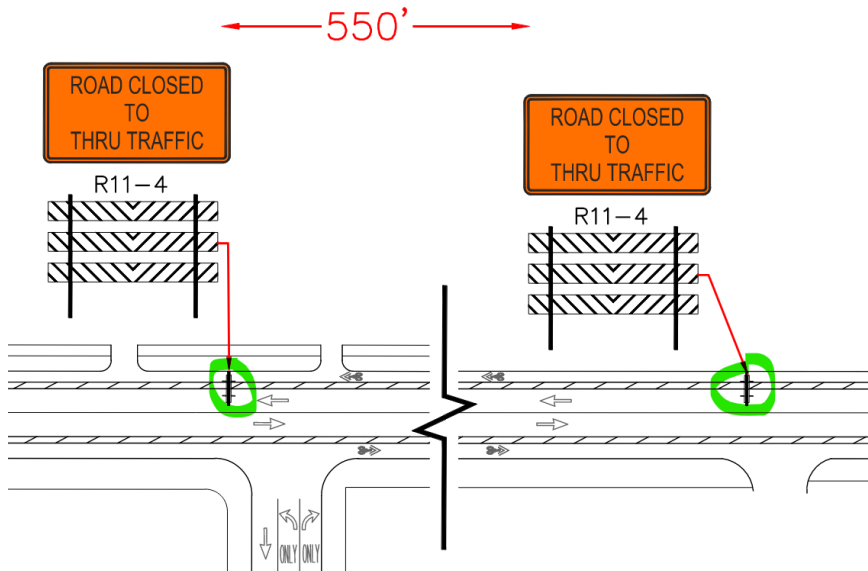

I walked this myself this morning, barricades were moved out of the bike lanes and into the road lanes as shown on our approved street plans (we had them set up properly so they must be getting moved by citizens), but as of this morning the signage is back in the street blocking the car lane to warn of closure / no thru traffic and you should be able to bike still as you get to Arch Street, and then you must detour.
