Hi Jasmine,

Thank you for reaching out.

First, I am so incredibly sorry for the delay in my response. After receiving your initial message, I immediately reached out to our legal staff to better understand the current state of drug enforcement in Ann Arbor. Unfortunately, I've had an incredibly busy couple of weeks since then, and I'm just catching up!

After speaking with our Assistant City Attorney who handles ordinance enforcement, I understand that we do not charge any possession of drug cases under city ordinance. Those cases are generally enforced by the County Prosecutor, Eli Savit, or the state of Michigan. My understanding is that the only cases that the city handles regarding "possession" are the open intoxication cases (that are heavily weighted toward excessively drunk people during football games – generally as a public health/welfare tool) and drunk/drugged driving cases, which obviously have significant public safety implications beyond the individual using.

All this said, I would be happy to make myself available to chat with you about your goals, share thoughts/feedback, and discuss a potential path forward. I would love to include our Asst. City Attorney in this conversation, if you'd be amenable to that, because she would be able to add considerable day-to-day enforcement & local justice system context to the conversation.

While I wholeheartedly agree that we must be better about treating substance use as a public health issue instead of a criminalization issue, candidly, I also have some concerns about aspects of the resolution that I think may be overly broad and/or don't fully account for the nuances that exist between individuals and their unique situations.

For example, my sister is a social worker currently focused on clients with substance use disorders – primarily new/expectant mothers. In conversations I've had with her and her colleagues, many of their clients would not be in treatment or seeking assistance for their children without intervention from our highly successful local drug treatment courts (which are, in many ways, already shifting the conversation around substance use from criminalization to public health, by enforcing treatment, rather than jail time.

Again, I would be happy to engage in this conversation to learn more about your perspectives and goals, and to see where we might have common ground to move forward specific policy objectives locally. In the meantime, if you haven't already, I would also encourage you to reach out to Prosecutor Savit and/or members of the County board as well.

If you're available, while it is short notice, I have the next few days off of work from my day-job and am starting to fill them with City-related meetings. If our City Attorney is available as well, would you have any availability to meet on Tuesday or early Wednesday?

I have a concern that I'd like to share with you regarding a proposed building in downtown Ann Arbor (212 Miller – proposed development). In a nutshell, my wife and I purchased our dream retirement home at 309 N Ashley, which we will move into in April/May 2022. We paid a large premium to get a higher third floor unit in the northwest corner, which has a wonderful west-facing view of northwest Ann Arbor

I just learned that there is a proposed development at 212 Miller, which will squeeze a four-story, eight condominiums building into a narrow lot occupied by a single family home. It will be just 15 feet away from our unit that will completely block our view and all sunlight; basically we will stare into another building (see picture of mockup below).
