The Ann Arbor City Council will conduct a public hearing at 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, January 18, 2022 in the City Hall Council Chamber, 2nd floor of the Guy C. Larcom, Jr. Municipal Building, 301 E. Huron Street, Ann Arbor, to hear all those interested in the proposed Ordinance No. ORD-21-40 – Wade Zoning. in the City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan as R1B (Single-Family Dwelling District).

<u>Section 2</u>. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after ten days from legal publication.
