## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing on the following items will be held by the Ann Arbor City Planning Commission on Tuesday, April 5, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.

Maple Cove II for City Planning Commission Approval – Proposal to construct a 70 unit apartment complex consisting of 3 buildings (79,482 square feet). Construction will include 86 vehicle parking spaces, 38 bicycle parking spaces, underground stormwater detention and associated utilities on this 2.56-acre site located at 1577, 1605, 1633 North Maple Road and 2510 Miller Road zoned O (Office). Project also includes a Wetland Use Permit to be reviewed in conjunction with the site plan.

Amendments to the Unified Development Code (UDC) Section 5.19 Parking Standards and Section 5.16.3.P Transit Corridor Developments regarding parking standards in order to reduce impervious surfaces, encourage land to be used efficiently, incentivize the construction of new residential uses, reduce the cost of constructing new residential units, and support transit service. Proposed amendments include: eliminating minimum parking requirements for all uses, consolidating parking use categories, eliminating some use categories, eliminating the ability to provide bicycle parking off-site, amending the weight limit of vehicles prohibited from parking in driveways, changing the standards and format of special parking district requirements already in place for D1 and D2 districts and including the TC1 district, and amending requirements to electric vehicle parking regulations.
