Moved by Borgsdorf, seconded by Marsan, to approve the Resolution to recommend approval of a Contract with Rauhorn Electric, Inc. for the Veterans Memorial Park Skatepark Lighting Project (\$269,955.00).

On a roll call vote, the vote was as follows with the Chair declaring the resolution approved.

Approved resolution reads as follows:

RESOLUTION TO RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF A CONTRACT WITH RAUHORN ELECTRIC, INC. FOR THE VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK SKATEPARK LIGHTING PROJECT (\$269,955.00) (ITB 4707)

Whereas, The Ann Arbor Skatepark is a world class facility that would greatly benefit from being lit during park hours; Whereas, The Skatepark Advisory Commission recommended that lighting be added to the Skatepark to allow skateboarding to safely occur year-round during regular park hours;

Whereas, The project supports the Parks and Recreation Open Space (PROS) Plan goals of providing exceptional user experience and a safe park system;

Whereas, The project meets the sustainability goals of promoting active living and learning and having a safe community;

Whereas, Funding for the Veterans Memorial Park Skatepark Lighting Project is available in the approved FY2022 Park Maintenance and Capital Improvements Millage budget;

Whereas, The Friends of the Ann Arbor Skatepark have raised \$20,000 in funds to contribute to the installation of the lighting; Whereas, Additional funding partners are being engaged and any additional funds received will offset the Park contribution;

RESOLVED, That the Park Advisory Commission recommend approving a contract with Rauhorn Electric, Inc. in the amount of \$269,655.00 for the Veterans Memorial Park Skatepark Lighting Project (ITB 4707);

RESOLVED, That a contingency amount of \$26,965.00 (10%) be established within the project budget for the life of the project

without regard to fiscal year, and that the City Administrator be authorized to approve change orders that do not to exceed the contingency amount.
