# AMENDMENT NUMBER 5 TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN WADE TRIM ASSOCIATES, INC. AND THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR FOR PROJECT MANAGEMENT AND CIVIL ENGINEERING SERVICES

The City of Ann Arbor, a Michigan municipal corporation, with offices at 301 E. Huron St. Ann Arbor, Michigan 48107-8647 ("City") and Wade Trim Associates, Inc., having its offices at 25251 Northline Road, Taylor, Michigan 48180 ("Contractor") agree to amend the professional services agreement for Project Management and Civil Engineering services executed by the parties dated December 1, 2017 ("Agreement") as follows:

1) Article II DURATION, is amended to read as follows:

This Agreement shall become effective on December 1, 2017 and shall remain in effect through December 31, 2023, unless terminated as provided for in Article XI.

2) Article V COMPENSATION OF CONTRACTOR, Paragraphs A and B, are amended to read as follows:

#### V. COMPENSATION OF CONTRACTOR

- Α. The Contractor shall be paid on the basis of the unit prices restated in Exhibit **B6**. The total fee to be paid to the Contractor shall be an undetermined amount, as it will be based on the number and size of projects assigned to the Contractor. Payment shall be made monthly, unless another payment term is specified in Exhibit B, following receipt of invoices submitted by the Contractor, and approved by the Contract Administrator. The Contractor shall be allowed to increase their unit rates annually to account for cost of living. This shall be done annually on the date of this agreement, by a percentage based on the Consumer Urban Consumers, Price Index for City of Detroit https://www.bls.gov/cpi/).
- B. The Contractor will be compensated for Services performed in addition to the Services described in Section III, only when those additional Services have received prior written approval of the Contract Administrator. Compensation will be on the basis of reasonable time spent and reasonable quantities of materials used, according to the schedule of rates in **Exhibit B6**. The Contract Administrator shall be the sole arbitrator of what shall be considered "reasonable" under this provision.
- 3) Exhibit B4 is replaced with the attached **Exhibit B6**.

All terms, conditions, and provisions of the original Agreement between the parties executed December 1, 2017, unless specifically amended above, shall apply to this Amendment and are made a part of this Amendment as though expressly rewritten, incorporated, and included herein.
