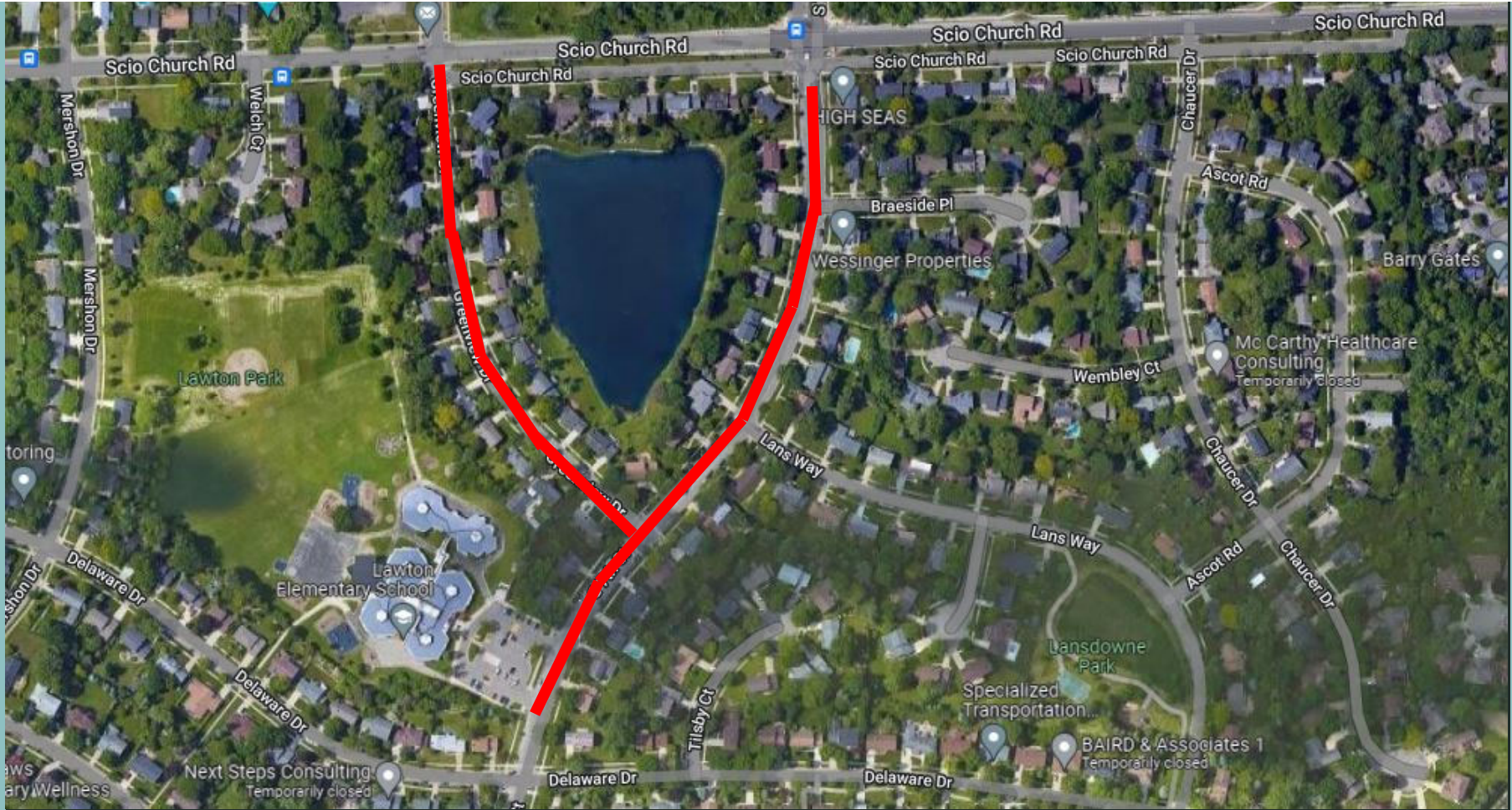

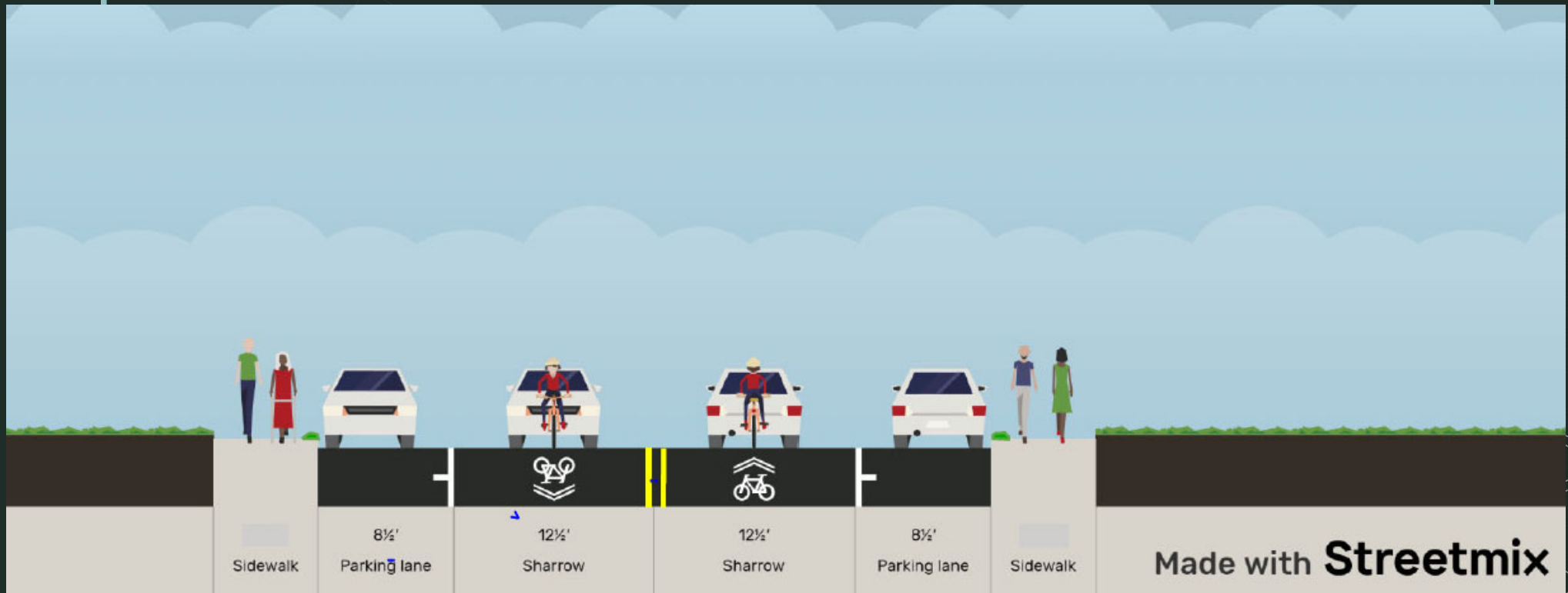

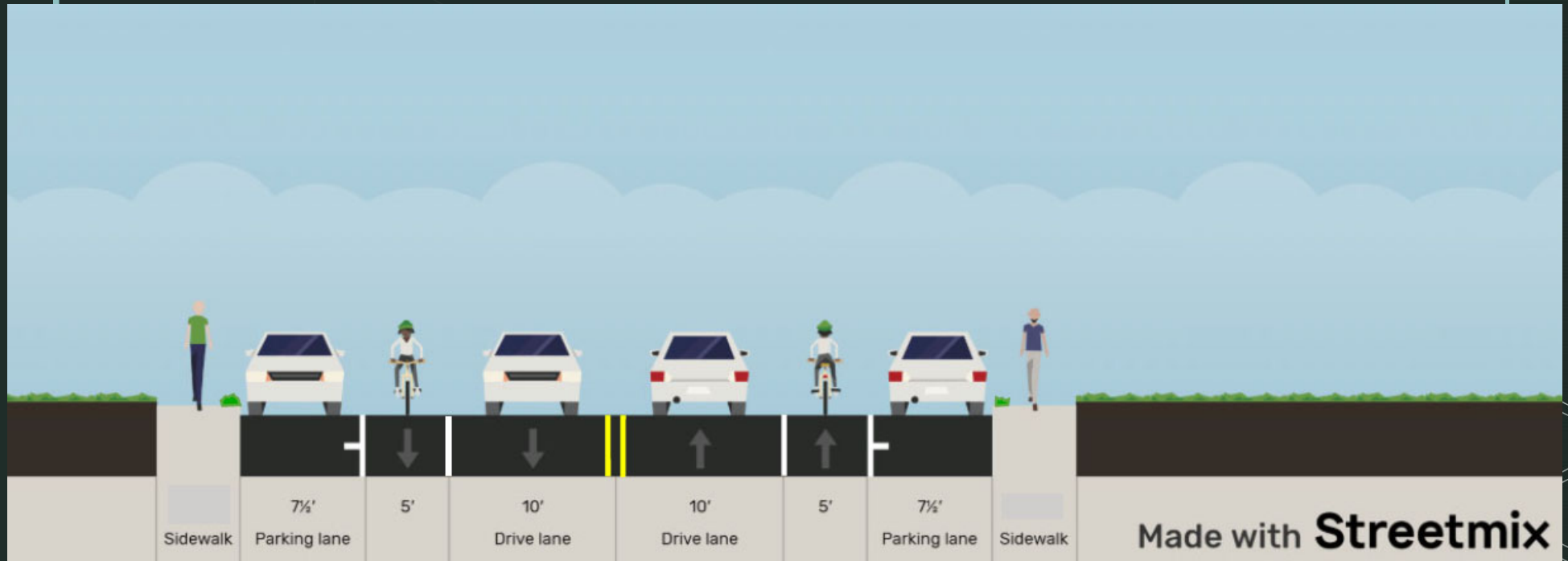
Existing Section: South Seventh



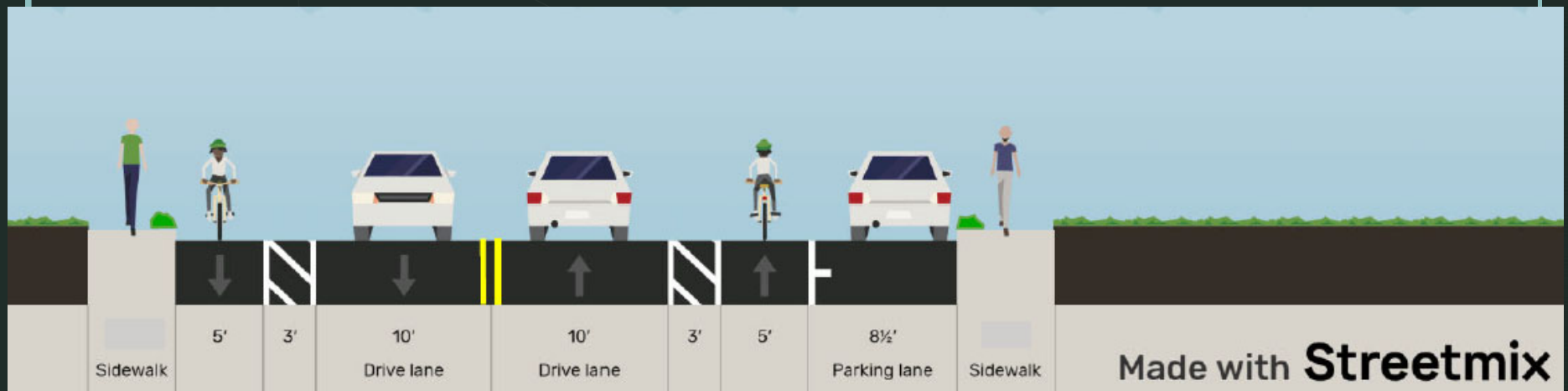
Proposed Full-Width Section Shared Use Space with Motorists



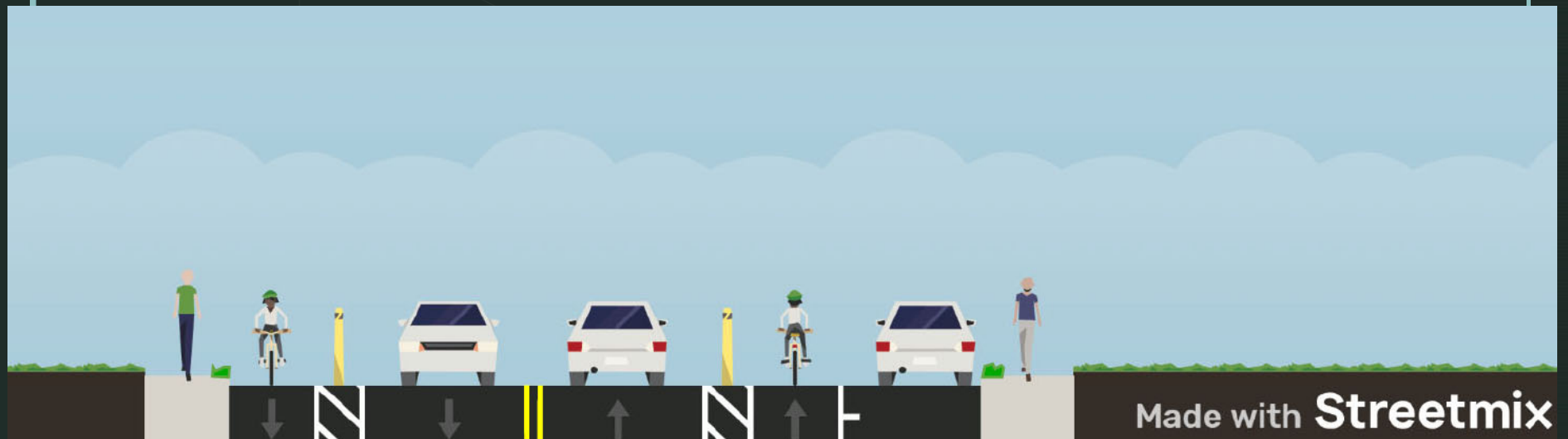
Proposed Full-Width Section Designated Bike Lane



Proposed Full-Width Section Buffered Bike Lane



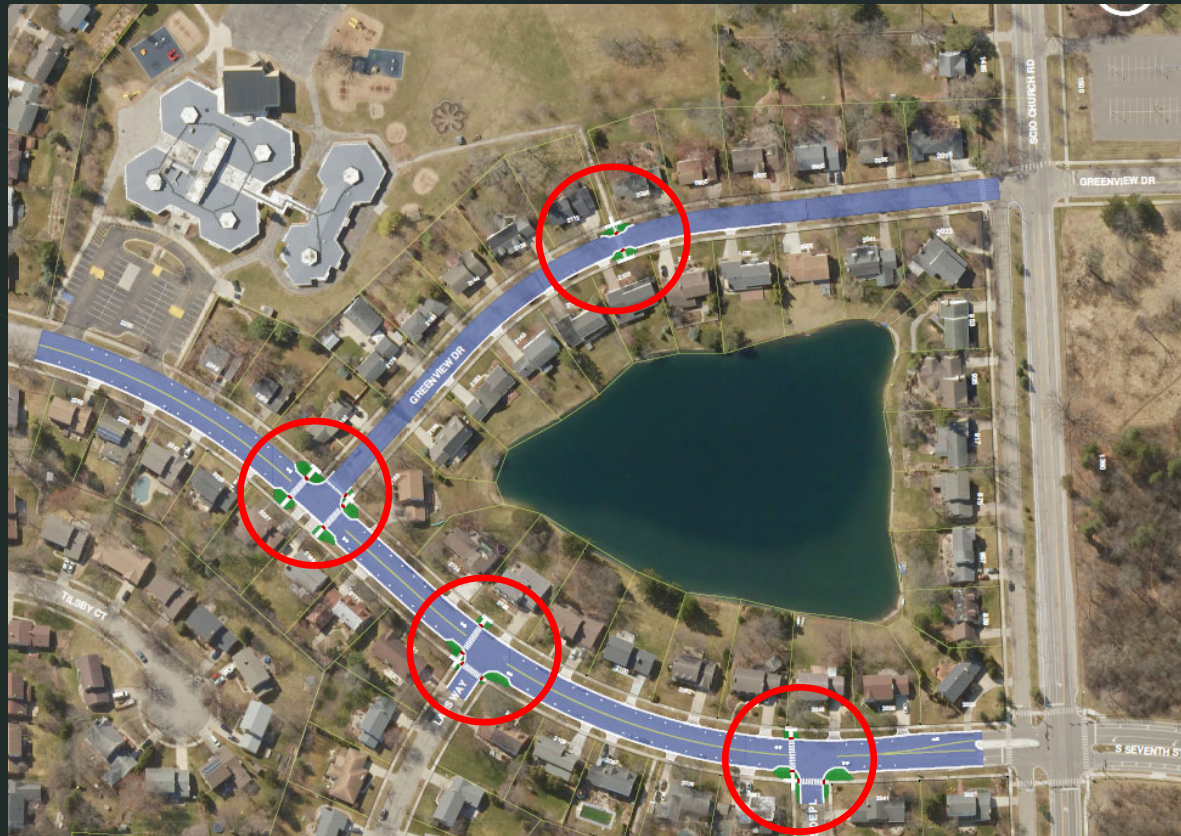
Proposed Full-Width Section Separated Bike Lane



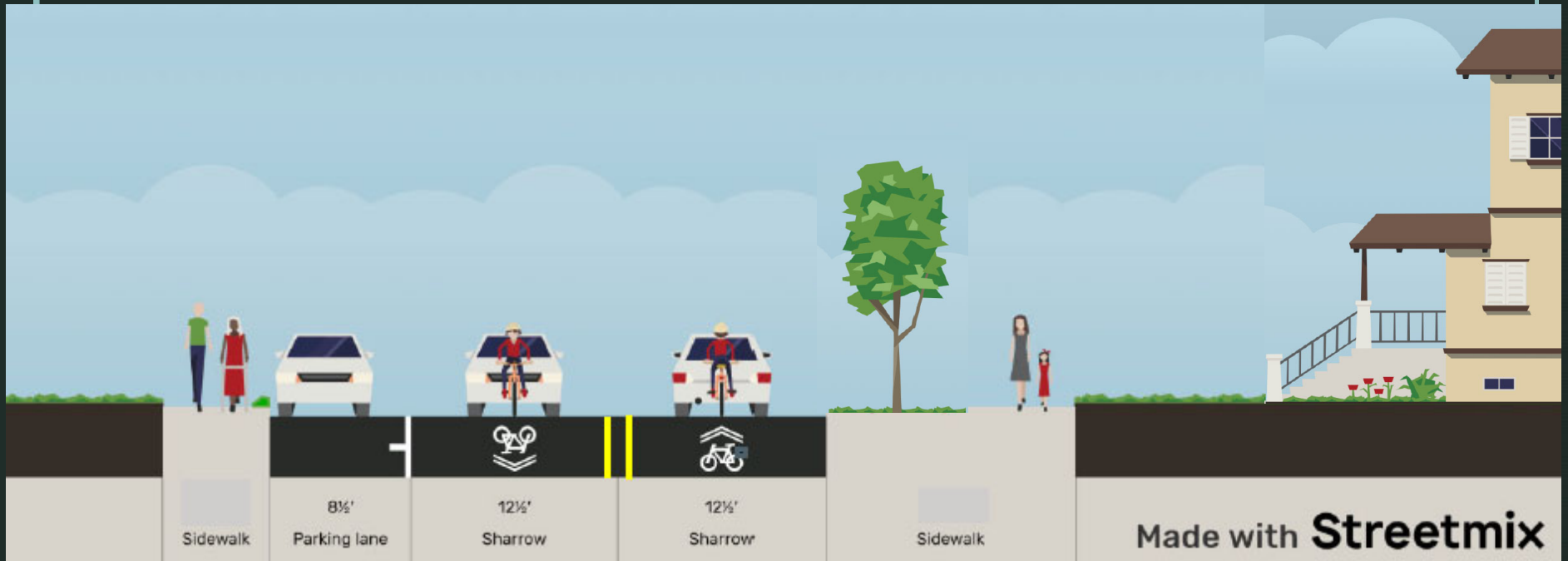

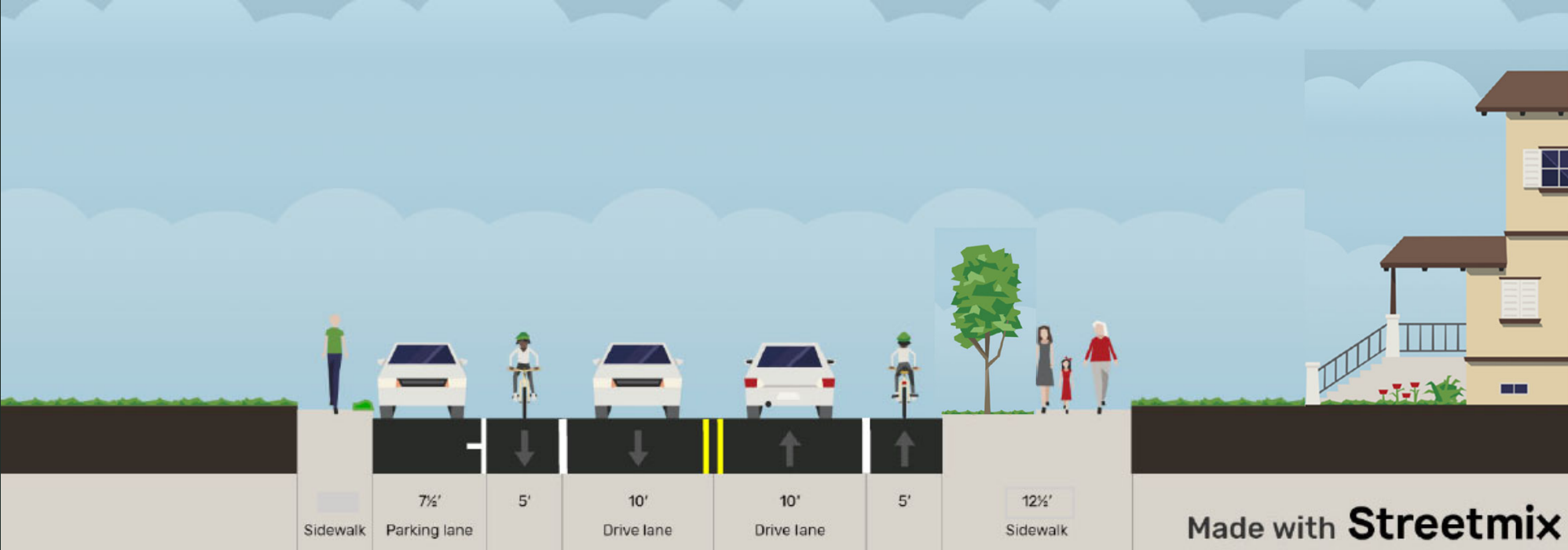
Proposed Bump-out Locations



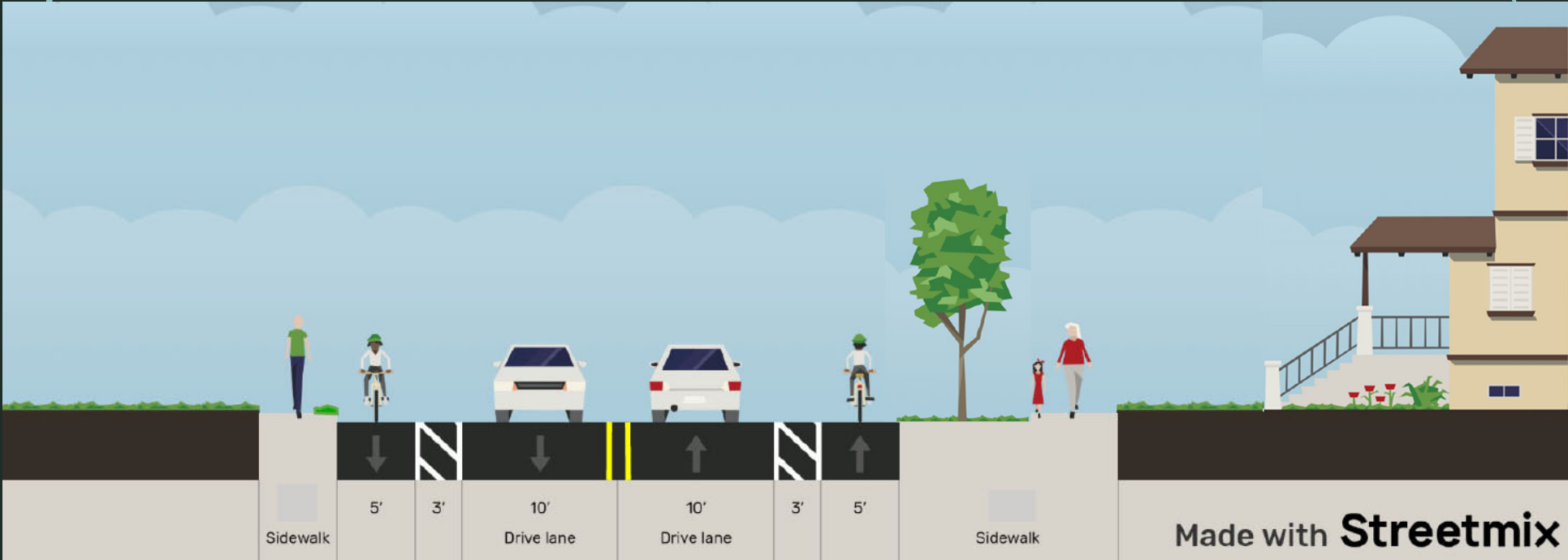
Proposed Single Bump-out Section Shared Use Space with Motorists



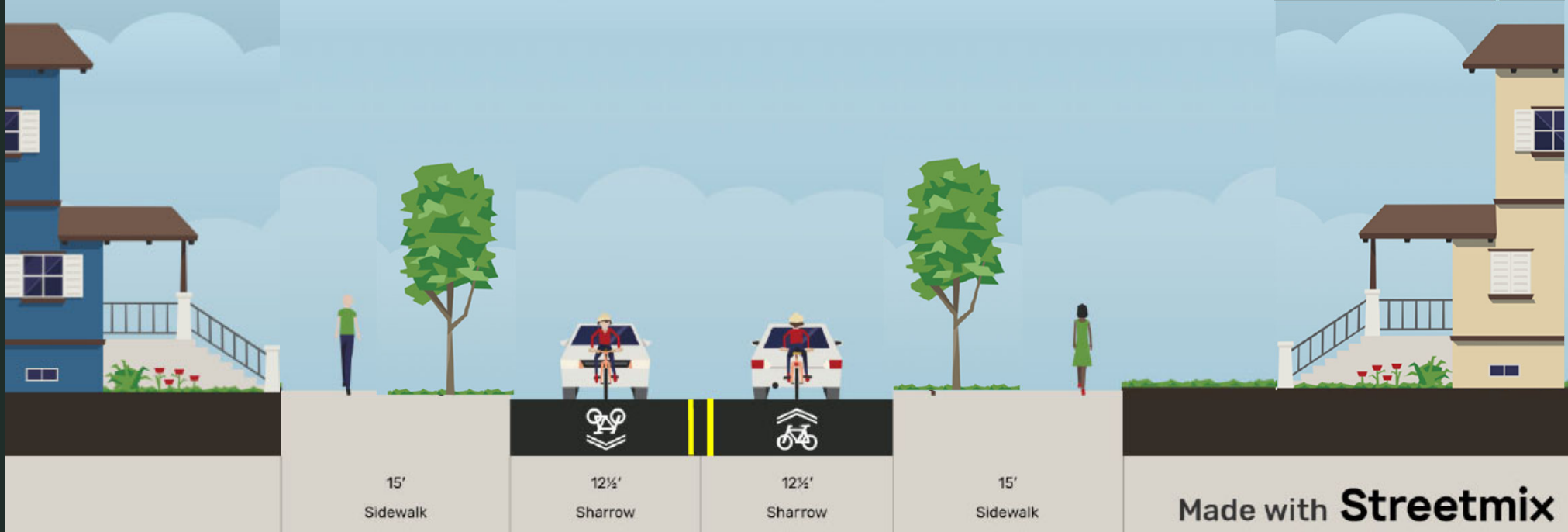
Proposed Single Bump-out Section Designated Bike Lane
