Authorized activity:

On Barton Pond, at three sites along the northern shoreline, place woody structures along the shoreline for erosion control and habitat.

Woody structures shall consist of the following:

One to three turtle logs, a single fish stick structure, and a multiple fish stick structure. The turtle logs will extend up to 50 feet lakeward of the Ordinary High-Water Mark (OHWM), the single fish stick will extend up to 65 feet lakeward of OHWM, and the multiple fish stick structure will extend up to 40 feet lakeward of the OHWM. Once woody structures have been set in place, they will be anchored securely to the shoreline. Anchoring will include the placement of up to 10 cubic yards of 12-to-18-inch riprap per woody structure. Woody structures shall be placed in such a manner that they will not impede navigation and will not impede access to the waterway.

All work shall be completed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications of this permit
