 - A blur of events and visits to Liberty Plaza!




Immediate Action Items (physical)


Open the sightlines throughout the Park

- Trimmed tree limbs
 - Removed one unhealthy tree
- Removed tables and stools
- Removed damaged historical marker

Create a welcoming space


- Power wash all hard surfaces
- Added temporary decorative lighting
- Daily trash picking

- Permanent decorative lighting and electrical
- Public Art
- Park signage
- Update landscape beds & plantings
- Replace damaged historical marker

- Public Wi-Fi

Event Challenges


- Mid-Summer start/launch

- Lack of onsite storage


