Ann Arbor Environmental Commission 2023 Legislative Policy Recommendations

Natural Features

- Revive the "Natural Resources Protection Act" of 1998 to protect biodiversity statewide. Sen. Sue Shink will introduce a Bill in 2023. Restore P.A. 451 of 1994 Part 355 that was rescinded in 2013? Chris & Brooks-please specify
- 2. Restore Driving License privileges <u>regardless of residency status</u>. Refer to Senate Bills 433, 434 and House Bills 4835, 4836 of 2021.
- 3. Eliminate legal impediments to annual deer culls, and promote them throughout Southern Michigan

Solid Waste

- 1. Amend Part 115 (2022) to prevent organic waste disposal in landfills.
- 2. Restrict the sale of all packaging that includes intentionally added PFAS chemicals. These contaminations prevent the recycling of plastics and toxic-free composts

Water Quality

- 1. Reinstate EGLE's rule making authority where it has been removed (e.g. Part 4 'Water Quality Standards')
- 2. Support <u>H.B. 4083</u> to ban use of perchloroethylene (PERC) in dry cleaning businesses

Pollinators

- 1. Mandate Integrated Pest Management IPM) as first-line treatments to limit the use of broad-spectrum pesticides
- 2. Ban sale of seeds treated with neonicotinoid pesticides.
- 3. Prioritize the use and maintenance of native plants on highway rights-of-way.
