- Working with WM on transition plan and communications




Winter Compost Update


- Began Winter 2022 with once-a-month collection for January, February, March
- Continued in Winter 2023
- Small volume collected
- Fewer issues with frozen carts in 2023



Percent of Annual (FY) Tons by Program Type



Future Metrics

- 1. Need to shift focus from weightbased rates to upstream measures, i.e., waste prevention
- 2. Evaluate feasibility and viability of per capita waste generation numbers
- 3. Continue to track tons landfilled, consider baseline
- 4. Evaluate feasibility and viability of capture rate
- 5. Evaluate qualitative measures that highlight successes that cannot be traditionally quantified






Proposed New Drop-Off Station Update
