NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS 415 WEST WASHINGTON PUD ZONING AND SITE PLAN (415 WEST WASHINGTON ST)

The Ann Arbor City Council will conduct public hearings at 7:00 p.m., Monday, April 17, 2023, in the City Hall Council Chamber, 2nd floor of the Guy C. Larcom, Jr. Municipal Building, 301 E. Huron Street, Ann Arbor, to hear all those interested in the proposed Ordinance No. ORD-23-10 — 415 West Washington PUD Zoning, and related site plan. The ordinance would rezone 2.5 Acres from PL (Public Land) to PUD (Planned Unit Development District,) 415 West Washington Street.

The proposed ordinance would amend the City Zoning Map, which is a part of Section 5.10.2 of Chapter 55, Title V of the Ann Arbor City Code.

Section 1. THE ZONING MAP, which, by Section 5.10.2 of Chapter 55 of Title V of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor is made a part of said Chapter 55, shall be so amended as to designate the zoning classification of property described as follows:

PARCEL 1

Lot 13, except that portion thereof described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of Lot 12, Block 2 of Assessor's Plat No. 3 and running thence North along the West line of Lot 13 in said Block, 40.58 feet and to the Southwest corner of land conveyed by Gottlieb Schneider and wife to the Board of County Road Commissioners of Washtenaw County by deed dated March 27, 1920 and recorded in Liber 219, Page 606, Washtenaw County Records; thence Easterly along the Southerly line of said land to a point on the West line of Lot 10 in said Block, 22 feet South of the Northwest corner of said Lot 10; thence South along the West line of said Lot 10, 56.89 feet and to the Northeast corner of Lot 11 in said Block; thence West along the North line of Lots 11 and 12 to the Place of Beginning; also except that portion thereof described as follows: Commencing at an iron pipe at the Northwest corner of Lot 10, Block 2 of Assessor's Plat No. 3, thence Southerly along the line between Lots 10 and 13 of said Assessor's Plat, 22 feet to an iron pipe for a Place of Beginning; thence Westerly through an interior angle of 88°14' to the right 123.8 feet to an iron pipe in the West line of said Lot 13; thence Easterly through an interior angle of 88°30' to the right 123.46 feet to the Westerly line of said Lot 10; thence Southerly along the Westerly line of said Lot 10; thence Southerly along the Westerly line of said Lot 10, 6 feet to the Place of Beginning;
