CALL TO ORDER

AIRPORT MANAGER REPORT

C-1 Project Update - Environmental Assessment

The FAA has completed their review of the Environmental Assessment (EA) of the proposed runway safety extension project and provided comments to the consultant. The consultant is reviewing the comments and making changes to the EA. The Finding of No Significant Impact is also being drafted for the FAA's review and comment.

C-2 Other Items

The Airport Manager reported that the installation of public wifi in the terminal building is still being targeted by the City's IT Unit, hopefully sometime in August. We are expecting a new recycling dumpster for the NW t-hangar area to be delivered soon. In early August, staff expects to install pavement markings on the new concrete that was recently repaired on Alpha taxiway. The lease with Herron Aviation Group for 719 Airport Drive has been finalized and they have taken occupancy as of July 1, 2023. The Airport has applied to MDOT-Aero to be considered for a pilot program as a multi-modal EV charging location in the State. They will be short listing airports this Fall for further consideration to move into phase 2 of the project.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Member Harshberger had some noise complaints to discuss under Unfinished Business, but nothing additional.

D-2 Discovery Area Report

The Chair was set up at the EAA Pancake Breakfast to discuss the project. He had some discussions regarding public art opportunities and fundraising for the project.

The draft Voluntary Noise Abatement Program Brochure was reviewed and suggested changes were offered. Distribution of the materials and inclusion in the AFD were also discussed. Updating the current noise abatement signage at the airfield was also considered.

David and George McCalla from Broadview Farms, farmers that provide agricultural service on the airport's property, had concerns with the recent decision to eliminate ag use inside the airport's fenced area. They indicated that they would be open to planting other crops inside the fence and would ask that the Committee reconsider their decision.
