3874 Research Park Drive Site Plan for City Council Approval - A proposal to construct a 110,800-square foot office/research/lab space as Phase II of this project for a new overall total of 241,100-square feet. A new 77-space parking lot is also proposed on this RE (Research District) and ORL (Office/Research/Limited Industrial District) zoned site totaling 16.9 acres.

2929 Plymouth Road Site Plan for City Planning Commission Approval – University of Michigan Credit Union is requesting demolition of the existing office building and constructing a one-story, 4,740-square foot building on this O (Office) zoned site.
