The Huron River Valley has already come under intense development pressure from various actors in the City, both public and private. But there is a different way to enhance the value of this precious, unique resource.

If the Huron River is to be "activated" as the popular word is bandied about, please consider incorporating *the work of Kongjian Yu*. This forward thinking landscape architect from China has received many prestigious awards in the past. Most recently he was honored with the 2023 Cornelia Hahn Oberlander International Landscape Architecture Prize, a bi-annnual, international award.

Mr. Yu's work focuses on integrating the ecology of the area with the management of the water along rivers and other bodies of water. His projects are sometimes called "sponge cities" because of the focus on stormwater management that uses innovative designs of natural wildlife habitats and plant choices. People interact with this environment through walkways, parks and so forth.
