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To Transportation Commission,  
I support these resolutions:

Where, after evaluation, staff advises against lane reduction, Transportation Commission recommends that the it be submitted to City Council and subject to their approval (an example may include near-term plans to convert a lane to dedicated bus transit);. Lane reductions are not recommended on major streets where dedicated bus lanes are anticipated in the near future;

The Transportation Commission recommends that City Council direct the City Administrator to partner with the Ann Arbor Transportation Authority to prioritize road projects that facilitate the integration of Bus Rapid Transit and nonmotorized improvements, such as floating bus stops to protect and enhance bicycle connectivity and pedestrian safety, along busy transit corridors;

The Transportation Commission recommends that City Council repeal the following resolved clause from R-18-275

Reducing major road lanes leads to backups and congestion.
