Subject: tracking scooter crashes in the city

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Hi Raymond and Transportation Commissioners. I have noticed that scooter crashes are not being treated consistently in the monthly reporting of crashes in the Administrator's report. For example, incident number 230023349 from June 2, 2023, was included in the July Administrator's report in the pedestrian section. The person seriously injured in the crash was on a scooter, not on foot.

In another example, a scooter rider was killed in a crash on July 8th, but this crash is not listed in the Administrator's report with the other pedestrian and bicycle crashes from July.

Can we agree on a convention for how the city will report crashes involving riders of scooters and other personal mobility vehicles? Looking forward to hearing everyone's thoughts on how best to do this.
