Architect C. Heuter spoke on the history of the project and asked for change of use exemption because the one granted in 1987 is now null and void.

Board members asked questions of the presenters and discussed the request.

B. Hart made the following motion:

That in the case of BBA23-0005, the appeal of the Building Official's decision that the work proposed at 311 E. Liberty is granted relief from Section 1027.5 of the 2015 Michigan Building Code and the Building Board of Appeals reverses the Building Official's decision for the reason that:

The applicant has proposed an equal or better form of construction. Stipulations are that the accessible ramp and means of egress for the first floor be located on the rear or north of the 311 Building with the provision that this condition is acceptable as long as the adjoining adjacent 301 existing building with four-hour exterior wall rating remain and the existing 311 Liberty building adjoining wall to the ramp retain its one-hour rating and that the deck be constructed of non-combustible material. The approval of this appeal shall not be considered as a precedent for future projects incurring similar conditions.

Motion passes unanimously.
