The most recent changes to the renewal ordinance are in effect for leases entered after March 16th, 2024. The previous version of the ordinance is still in effect for leases entered after October 16th, 2022. Here is a guide that outlines the ordinance for leases entered after October 16th, 2022: https://www.a2gov.org/departments/city-clerk/Documents/ELO%20and%20RTR%20Guide.pdf
After reviewing the guide, if you determine that your landlord may be in violation of the ordinance or if you have a question about your specific situation, the City of Ann Arbor Rental Housing Services department is the best resource. This department enforces the renewal ordinance and can accept complaints.
