Your application will not be considered unless this page is signed and submitted at the time of initial application submission.

The signer acknowledges and agrees to the following:

1. He/she is an authorized representative of the community or agency submitting the application (hereinafter referred to as the “applicant”);
2. The applicant is eligible to apply for and receive CRP funding as defined by Michigan Act 51 of 1951 (i.e., the applicant is an incorporated city, incorporated village, county road commission, or public transit agency within the meaning of the Act);
3. The applicant is responsible for ensuring that all of the application requirements are met, within the schedule as provided by SEMCOG. The applicant further understands that failure to meet these deadlines will result in the rejection of the application;
4. The applicant will provide SEMCOG with any subsequently requested information related to the CRP application;
5. It is the applicant’s responsibility to confirm that the application has been submitted and also to check on the status of the application after it has been submitted;
6. If an application is submitted for funding, it may or may not receive funding, depending upon how it ranks with other applications competing for funding in the same fiscal year, and its eligibility for CRP funding.
7. SEMCOG may, at its discretion, choose to accept applications from Act 51 agencies submitted on behalf of non-Act 51 entities (i.e., for-profit organizations, nonprofit organizations, townships, etc.). However, these projects must be sponsored by the Act-51 eligible agency submitting the application. The sponsorship agreement **must be signed** at the time of initial submission of the CRP application. **APPLICATIONS RECEIVED DIRECTLY FROM NON-ACT-51 ENTITIES WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**
8. If the applicant’s application is approved for funding, SEMCOG may, at its discretion, award less or more federal CRP funding than requested.
9. SEMCOG, at its discretion, may rescind an award if funding is no longer available from the federal government, if the project description as submitted with the application is subsequently changed, or if the applicant is not ready to flex (transit) by May 15th or obligate (highway and other) the funding by June 30 of the fiscal year for which it was awarded. “Flexed” and “Obligated” each carry the same definition as commonly used by the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT). It is the APPLICANT’s responsibility to ensure that its awarded application is ready for flexing or obligation, as appropriate.
10. For projects that span multiple years (for example, new transit service over a three-year period), the applicant understands and accepts that SEMCOG only awards funding by specific fiscal year, and that funding for a particular project in one fiscal year DOES NOT GUARANTEE funding for that project in any subsequent fiscal year. All CRP funds awarded for a given fiscal year must either be flexed (transit) or obligated (highway and other) in that fiscal year.
