






FIFTH + DIVISION TWO-WAY RESTORATION

CIRCULATION IMPROVEMENTS

- Two-way restoration of 5th & Division (plus Beakes)
- "Broadway Interchange" area requires significant infrastructure – but also opportunity for improvement to a challenging area.
- Assessing Ann St. for restoration to two-way
- Anticipated to improve safety and navigation




