

## City of Farmington Hills, Qakland County, Michigan RESOLUTION R-151-11

## In Support of Remedying Statutory Court Funding Inequities among Communities

The following resolution was offered by Councilmember Brickner and supported by Councilmember Oliverio:

WHEREAS, the district court jurisdictional structure in Oakland County was created in 1968 by MCL 600.8123, establishing nine separate third class district courts and a single, four division second class district court; and

WHEREAS, MCL 600.8103 vests responsibility for "maintaining, financing and operating" third class district courts to the political subdivisions comprising the district while assigning those responsibilities to the County for second class district courts; and

WHEREAS, for fiscal year 2010-11, Farmington Hills and Farmington contributed \$3,008,527 to the operating budget of the 47<sup>th</sup> District Court and an additional \$867,825 toward the debt on the 47<sup>th</sup> District Court facility amounting to a total fiscal year investment of \$3,876,352; and

WHEREAS, for fiscal year 2010-11, Farmington Hills and Farmington received \$3,019,193 in court-generated revenue resulting in a net total expenditure on court operations and facility of \$857,159; and

WHEREAS, cities, townships and villages in Oakland County under the jurisdiction of the second class 52<sup>nd</sup> District Court, including Novi, Troy, Rochester/Rochester Hills, and Clarkston, made no direct contribution to the operations of a district court, but received one third of the court-generated revenue on cases from their jurisdiction (e.g. Troy budgeted \$1,212,000 in fines/forfeiture revenue for 2011 with no court-related expenditures); and

WHEREAS, the taxpayers of third class district communities such as Farmington Hills and Farmington pay property taxes to Oakland County to support the 52<sup>nd</sup> District Court, from which they receive no services, while also paying taxes to support district court services in their own communities, unlike communities within the jurisdiction of the 52<sup>nd</sup> District Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Farmington Hills does hereby recommend and support amending and restructuring the state funding of third class judicial districts—whether by legislation, revisions to the statutory revenue sharing distribution formula, or other action—to address and remedy the financial inequity third class judicial district funding units/taxpayers must bear compared to those communities/taxpayers within the jurisdiction of a second class district court in the same county.
