Authorization to Release the Five Year Transit Program for Public Review

WHEREAS, the Ann Arbor Transportation Authority (AATA) Board of Directors (Board) has developed a thirty-year Transit Master Plan (TMP) to improve public transit services and provide them on a county-wide basis, and

WHEREAS, as a means to begin the implementation of the TMP, the Board has previously produced a Draft Five Year Transit Program (FYTP) detailing a scalable set of transit improvements recommended for the first five years of the TMP, and

WHEREAS, the general public and numerous public and private sector leaders have offered comments aimed at refining and finalizing the draft document, and

WHEREAS, it is important to the success of the TMP that the initial implementation plans of the FYTP be reviewed, understood, and accepted by the community to insure that they accurately reflect the transit priorities of the public, now therefore

IT IS RESOLVED, that the Board authorizes the release of the final document entitled "Washtenaw County Transit Master Plan: Five Year Transit Program" to the public so that public meetings may be held throughout Washtenaw County to afford further discussions of the FYTP, and of issues related to funding and governance of expanded transportation in Washtenaw County.
