The City of Ann Arbor Election Commission Meeting was called to order by the City Clerk Jacqueline Beaudry at 2:03 p.m., in the Council Work Room, Guy C. Larcom Municipal Building, 301 E. Huron Street, Ann Arbor, MI, 48104.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

PUBLIC COMMENT

Joe Baublis, member of the public, stated he has been a precinct inspector in the past, but was denied appointment this election due to his candidacy as a County Commissioner. Mr. Baublis stated he believes he is still eligible for appointment in a precinct other than those that are in his County Commissioner district. He stated he has filed a complaint with the Michigan Bureau of Elections and would like the Election Commission to postpone action until that time.

City Clerk Beaudry noted that the 21-day deadline to make election inspector appointments was today and that a decision could not be postponed.

David Parker, member of the audience, stated he too is a County Commissioner candidate and was denied an election inspector appointment in another precinct.

Postema moved, seconded by Seto, that the Commission reconsider Resolution EC-12-005. The motion carried on a voice vote.

The Commission discussed the relevant sections of the law relating to the appointment of election inspectors. Senior Assistant City Attorney Mary Fales was present to discuss the law and answer questions.
