COMMISSIONER PROPOSED BUSINESS

Commissioner Lada brought up the issue of parking and big box trucks in the market. She wanted to know if anything had been done by market staff to work on improving parking and more consistent regulation of truck parking at vendor stalls. Market manager Sarah DeWitt explained that the City's new Safety Manager would be visiting Parks Facilities in the course of his orientation to city facilities. Prior to this visit, DeWitt planned to continue to work with vendors to handle parking challenges for vendors on market days.

Commissioner Santacroce proposed a commission evaluation of the possibility of closing Detroit Street between Catherine and 5th Ave on Saturdays during peak market season. Santacroce will bring a list of proposed tasks for the commission to review and delegate at the next regular meeting of the Public Market Advisory Commission.
