The Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a public hearing to consider DTE Electric Company's (DTE Electric) February 12, 2015 application, which seeks approval to amend its EO plan, for authority to implement its proposed amended EO plan surcharges and a Performance Incentive Mechanism and associated charges pursuant to the provisions of PA 295 of 2008. The Company represents that its proposed amended EO plan is designed to deliver significant electric savings to all customer classes, including low-income residential and small business customers. DTE Electric represents that the Company's costs will be recovered from residential customers on a levelized per-kilowatt hour (kWh) basis beginning January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2017. The Company is also requesting approval of levelized per-meter surcharges for the commercial and industrial primary rate classes and another set of levelized per-meter surcharges for the commercial and industrial secondary rate classes for the time period of January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2017. DTE Electric's summary of the

Company's proposed EO surcharges is contained in its application. DTE Electric is also seeking Commission approval for recovery of annual EO base revenue of \$90.7 million in 2016 and \$91.1 million in 2017, with a total of approximately \$181.8 million between 2016 and 2017.

All documents filed in this case shall be submitted electronically through the Commission's E-Dockets website at: michigan.gov/mpscedockets. Any person wishing to appear at the hearing to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case may participate by filing an appearance. To file an appearance, the individual must attend the hearing and advise the presiding administrative law judge of his or her wish to make a statement of position. All information submitted to the Commission in this matter becomes public information, thus available on the Michigan Public Service Commission's website, and subject to disclosure. Please do not include information you wish to remain private.
