#### Action Item #2- Approve December 9, 2014 Meeting Minutes

**Ms. Perry motioned** to approve December 9, 2014 minutes. **Mr. Muth seconded**. Committee unanimously approved.

### Information Item #1: FY15 Dean Fund Budget and Project Update

FY15 Budget: \$7,895.76 has been spent to date. There is \$14,000 for tree purchases and \$6,000 structural pruning that has not been accounted for. Note that it takes several weeks for all activities to post to the Dean Fund account. Therefore, some work that has been completed may not be reflected in this month's budget report.

**Structural Pruning:** Forestry has been doing structural pruning in Fox Fire in the northeast part of the city. Have spent approximately \$6,000 (not reflected in the budget report). \$4000 more for Foxfire (\$10,000 total). Move into the Orchard Hills/Georgetown neighborhood soon.

Crabapples on Vesper- remove and replace 10 this year, and then in a few years remove and replace additional so we're not removing all the trees at one time so as not to do it all at once.

### Discussion Item #1: Vet's Park Rejuvenation Project

Sue Perry, Steve Goebel, and Kerry Gray Vet's Park- Identified approximately 25 trees to be planted to either fill in vacancies or replace dead/dying trees. 5 stumps to be removed (sites replanted)
Remove 2 dying trees and replace
Pruning the remaining trees

Total project cost approximately \$10,000 would be done in FY 16 (after July 1). Staff would ensure that the species of crabapple flower the same color as the existing.

Develop a Work Plan for each project that has been done by the Dean Fund identifying activities that need to be completed.

- Cabling trees—approximately \$200 per tree
- Vet's Park rejuventation project
- Ask crew about areas for project.
