Body

Whereas, The Ann Arbor City Council received a written letter of resignation from Steve Powers, the City Administrator, effective November 18, 2015;

Whereas, The City Administrator is selected and approved by the Ann Arbor City Council:

Whereas, The Administrative Committee of the Ann Arbor City Council, which has personnel responsibilities including the performance review of the City Administrator and the City Attorney, should serve as the search committee with the goal of recommending at least three finalists;

Whereas, The Administration Committee has met to devise and recommend a selection process for the new city administrator and to recommend an interim city administrator for approval at the October 5th City Council meeting;

Whereas, The Administration Committee requested the distribution of the City Administrator job description to all of City Council for their review and input prior to October 1st;

Whereas, The Administration Committee met with Human Resources to discuss various options for the selection process for a new City Administrator;

Whereas, The Administration Committee reviewed and discussed steps for hiring a new city administrator, steps that will include will include posting the job; stakeholder meetings that consist of individual council members, employees, businesses and the community at large; and onsite public interviews with finalists;

Whereas, Human Resources has received proposals from three (3) search firms with expertise in public sector search and experience with executive recruitments;

Whereas, Human Resources has reviewed the three (3) received proposals and recommends the selection of Affion Public ("Affion");

Whereas, The Administration Committee recommends a search process that is a combination internal and external process (public input into desired candidate profile, public engagement at finalist stage), facilitated by Affion;

Whereas, The Administration Committee requested and reviewed a salary matrix from other cities for the City Administrator position and recommends that the posted salary for the new City Administrator be set at a range between \$160,000.00 and \$175,000.00 per year;

Whereas, The Administration Committee requested that City Administrator Steve Powers recommend an interim City Administrator; and

Whereas, City Administrator Steve Powers has recommended the selection of Tom Crawford to serve as interim City Administrator;

Resolved, That the Administration Committee of the Ann Arbor City Council be authorized to serve as the search committee and will make recommendations to City Council in its entirety regarding candidates for City Administrator;

Tonight's Snow/Ice Proposal

Copy of my recent response to CM Warpehoski re tonight's proposal on snow.ice removal.

Chuck -

Many thanks for taking the time to explain what's being proposed tonight and the reasons for it. I understand the implementation time crunch...sort of. But this scenario will also make it very easy to institutionalize what is approved tonight with no further improvement down the line. I've lived in Ann Arbor long enough to know that. This is our version of congressional "kicking the can down the road."

- 1) For the record and just so you know, I had no hand in any of the action alerts that may have gone out on this issue.
- 2) Perhaps many in Ann Arbor, including some on Council, are simply too spoiled. Certainly many people in other municipalities we cited in our list work 12 hour shifts or have a 12 hour day when commute time is factored in, but somehow it is by and large managed. You make these changes sound so big, so difficult in terms of their impact and people's ability to cope. Remember, Chuck, many people deal with much bigger problems in life and somehow manage. In the overall business of life the changes our Task Force proposed are relatively minor and do not represent not the hardships you and others on Council make them out to be. I certainly remember, as a kid, seeing my father get up an hour earlier because there had been a snowfall during the night and he had to jack up the car and put chains on before going to work, or had to shovel a long drive, and sidewalks, after a long, hard day's work. And what about the disabled person for whom it takes an hour to get dressed in the morning and another hour or two to get out of the house in a wheelchair and somehow try to wheel their way to and from work or to/from an uncleared bus stop because property owners have until the FOLLOWING morning to clean their walks? What are the disabled supposed to do just stay house-bound and off work for a day just so other residents can take 18 or 24 hours to get their act together and get the walks cleaned? I have no sympathy for the pampered of Ann Arbor who could clear their sidewalks in less time than it takes the above person to get dressed in the morning.
- 3) You note that "... there are conditions in which the ice adheres to the sidewalk and cannot be cleared in the relevant window." In most cases those very conditions are because you are allowing too large a time window for removal. It is a combination of compaction from foot traffic and a 24 hour thaw/freeze cycle that is most often responsible for the conditions you note.
- 4) Why has Council to-date not taken the lead in developing a program to provide assistance for those physically unable to clear their walks AND who are also unable to afford to hire someone to do same? Will there be a commitment to that end in what is proposed tonight? Not having such a program in place is being used as a reason not to strengthen the ordinance, and that seems pretty backwards to me.
- 5) I don't understand the rational for holding residential properties to a lesser standard than commercial ones. This differentiation ignores the needs of pedestrian commuters, of which Ann Arbor has a relatively high proportion. NOR IS IT CLEAR TO ME THAT THE CURRENT OR PROPOSED CHANGES REALLY DO HOLD COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES TO A HIGHER STANDARD...OR PERHAPS 4:60 (1) IS POORLY WORDED, BECAUSE I THINK IT SAYS THAT SNOW WHICH ACCUMULATES AFTER 6 AM DOES NOT HAVE TO BE

REMOVED UNTIL NOON OF THE FOLLOWING DAY...OR JUST SHY OF 30 HOURS. If I am misreading this others will too.



<u>2)</u> Except for sidewalks defined by section <u>4:51(1)(b)</u> and (c), within 24 hours after the end of each accumulation of snow greater than 1 inch, the owner or occupant of every residentially zoned property zoned residential shall:

(a) during the season beginning in 2016 and ending in 2017,

remove the any accumulation of snow of greater than 1 inch and any compacted snow of greater than ½ inch from the adjacent public sidewalk and from walks and ramps that are at bus stops or leading that lead to a marked or unmarked crosswalk. The accumulation may be from any source including precipitation and drifting. Immediately after the accumulation of ice on such sidewalk, walk or ramp, it shall be treated with sand, salt or other substance to prevent it from being slippery and the ice shall be removed within 24 hours after accumulation.

(b) during the season beginning in 2017 and in subsequent seasons, remove the entire accumulation of snow from the adjacent sidewalk and from walks and ramps that are at bus stops or that lead to a marked or unmarked crosswalk.
