Information Item #1: FY15 Dean Fund Budget and Project Update

FY15 Budget: \$10.515.77 has been spent to date. There are tree purchases, staff/equipment time for tree planting and structural pruning staff/equipment time that has not posted to the Dean Fund budget yet. It may take some time for purchases, staff and equipment time to post to the Dean Fund account; some work that has been completed may not be reflected in this month's budget report.

Structural Pruning: Forestry has been doing structural pruning in Foxfire and Skydale neighborhoods and will soon move into the Orchard Hills/Georgetown neighborhood. Steve Goebel will provide a count of the number of trees pruned to date at the April meeting.

Vesper Project: Crabapples on Vesper the plan is to remove and replace approximately 10 this year, and then in a few years remove and replace additional so we're not removing all the trees at one time. The remaining trees will be pruned after they have flowered this spring.

Mr. Muth would prefer to move the money out of the structural pruning budget to another project if there is any unspent.
