## AMENDMENT NUMBER THREE TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN CARLISLE/WORTMAN ASSOCIATES, INC. AND THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR

The City of Ann Arbor, a Michigan municipal corporation, with offices at 301 E. Huron St. Ann Arbor, Michigan 48107-8647 ("City") and Carlisle/Wortman Associates, Inc, having its offices at 605 S. Main Street, Ste 1, Ann Arbor, MI 48104 ("Contractor") agree to amend the professional services agreement for City Planning Services Unit Support Services between the parties dated August 31, 2015, and subsequently amended by Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement, dated September 22, 2015 and Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement, dated December 7, 2015, and as follows:

- 1) Article IV, Compensation of Contractor, is amended (bold italic) to read as follows:
  - A. The Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in Exhibit B-1, which is attached to and made a part of Amendment No. 2. Payment shall be made monthly, unless another payment term is specified in Exhibit B-1, following receipt of invoices submitted by the Contractor, and approved by the Contract Administrator. Total compensation payable for all Services performed during the term of this Agreement shall not exceed *One Hundred Thirty-five Thousand and no/100 dollars* (\$135,000.00)

All terms, conditions, and provisions of the original agreement between the parties executed August 31, 2015, Amendment No. 1, dated September 22, 2015, and Amendment No. 2, dated December 7, 2015 and subsequently amendments unless specifically amended above, are to apply to this amendment and are made a part of this amendment as though expressly rewritten, incorporated, and included herein. This amendment to the agreement between the parties shall be binding on the heirs, successors and assigns of the parties.
