# CITY OF ANN ARBOR NON-DISCRIMINATION ORDINANCE

Relevant provisions of Chapter 112, Nondiscrimination, of the Ann Arbor City Code are included below. You can review the entire ordinance at www. a2gov.org/departments/city-clerk

<u>Intent</u>: It is the intent of the city that no individual be denied equal protection of the laws; nor shall any individual be denied the enjoyment of his or her civil or political rights or be discriminated against because of actual or perceived age, arrest record, color, disability, educational association, familial status, family responsibilities, gender expression, gender identity, genetic information, height, HIV status, marital status, national origin, political beliefs, race, religion, sex, sexual orientation, source of income, veteran status, victim of domestic violence or stalking, or weight.

<u>Discriminatory Employment Practices</u>: No person shall discriminate in the hire, employment, compensation, work classifications, conditions or terms, promotion or demotion, or termination of employment of any individual. No person shall discriminate in limiting membership, conditions of membership or termination of membership in any labor union or apprenticeship program.

<u>Discriminatory Effects</u>: No person shall adopt, enforce or employ any policy or requirement which has the effect of creating unequal opportunities according to actual or perceived age, arrest record, color, disability, educational association, familial status, family responsibilities, gender expression, gender identity, genetic information, height, HIV status, marital status, national origin, political beliefs, race, religion, sex, sexual orientation, source of income, veteran status, victim of domestic violence or stalking, or weight for an individual to obtain housing, employment or public accommodation, except for a bona fide business necessity. Such a necessity does not arise due to a mere inconvenience or because of suspected objection to such a person by neighbors, customers or other persons.

Nondiscrimination by City Contractors: All contractors proposing to do business with the City of Ann Arbor shall satisfy the contract compliance administrative policy adopted by the City Administrator in accordance with the guidelines of this section. All city contractors shall ensure that applicants are employed and that employees are treated during employment in a manner which provides equal employment opportunity and tends to eliminate inequality based upon any classification protected by this chapter. Complaint Procedure: If any individual has a grievance alleging a violation of this chapter, he/she has 180 calendar days from the date of the individual's knowledge of the allegedly discriminatory action or 180 calendar days from the date when the individual should have known of the alleged discriminatory action to file a complaint with the city's Human Rights Commission. If an individual fails to file a complaint alleging a violation of this chapter within the specified time frame, the complaint will not be considered by the Human Rights Commission. The complaint should be made in writing to the Human Rights Commission. The complaint may be filed in person with the City Clerk, by e-mail at <a href="mailto:aahumanrightscommission@gmail.com">aahumanrightscommission@gmail.com</a>, or by mail (Ann Arbor Human Rights Commission, PO Box 8647, Ann Arbor, MI 48107). The complaint must contain information about the alleged discrimination, such as name, address, phone number of the complainant and location, date and description of the alleged violation of this chapter.

<u>Private Actions For Damages or Injunctive Relief:</u> To the extent allowed by law, an individual who is the victim of discriminatory action in violation of this chapter may bring a civil action for appropriate injunctive relief or damages or both against the person(s) who acted in violation of this chapter

## **DESCRIPTION:**

- Supply and Install RKI Model S5680 Utility Bodies, or approved equivalent, on the following:
  - 1. Four (4) 2016 Ford F-250 4X4 cab and chas sis with single rear wheels and a 137" WB and a 56" CA.
  - 2. One (1) 2016 Ford F-350 4X2 cab and chassis with single rear wheels and a 137" WB and a 56" CA.
  - 3. One (1) 2015 GMC Sierra 3500 4X4 cab and chassis with single rear wheels and a 137" WB and a 56" CA.
- NOTE: Cab and Chassis will be supplied by the City of Ann Arbor.

#### **BODY:**

- RKI Model S5680 or approved equivalent.
- Overall dimension of 96" long by 80" wide with a box depth of 14 ½".
- Body shall have 51" wide bed area (between boxes), an overall height of 44" with 29" from bed to top of boxes.
- Body constructed of 14 gauge galvanneal steel.
- Understructure to consist of 3 full length 14 gauge formed longitudinals with two 3/16"
   A50 high strength steel formed crossmembers (one each at front and rear) and two 10 gauge high strength steel formed intermediate crossmembers.
- Bed area to be covered with 12 gauge treadplate.
- Complete bed area including sides and the box tops shall be sprayed with Rhino-Lining.

## DOORS:

- All doors shall be double panel with 14 gauge galvanneal outer panel and 18 gauge galvanneal inner panel.


